
Inviting your scout to Scoutbook


After they turn 13, and you feel they are ready, you can invite your scout to Scoutbook. They will receive troop communications from Scoutbook in accordance with BSA Scouting's Youth Protection standards. All communications with your scout through Scoutbook will automatically include their parents. Also they will be easily able to keep track of what Advancements they are working on!

First, find your scout in Scoutbook. Then choose "Edit Profile" as shown below.



This will open a new page. Scroll all the way to the bottom of this new page.

Select "Invite Scout to Connect"




This will then open a pop up window for you to enter their email address.



After entering their address, hit "Invite" to send the invite to their email.

They will recieve a message like below with a temporary password. Have them log in to Scoutbook with this password.



Once they log in, they will be asked to create a new password. Be sure to save their password somewhere safe!
