The **Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook** consists of four sections:

- Eagle Scout Service Project Proposal
- Eagle Scout Service Project Final Plan
- Eagle Scout Service Project Fundraising Application
- Eagle Scout Service Project Report

The Eagle Scout Service Project Proposal

- 1. Figure out what you want to do for your Eagle Project. You can get a lot of ideas from the Web.
- 2. Discuss your idea with the Scoutmaster and Troop Eagle Project Coach to see if your preliminary project idea meets the criteria for an Eagle Project.
- 3. Begin writing your Project Proposal. Make sure you use the current edition of the **Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook**.
- 4. Begin filling in the Fundraising Application as well, with as much information that is known at this time.
- 5. Email your Project Proposal to the Troop Eagle Project Coach for review.
- 6. Once the Troop Eagle Project Coach is satisfied with your writeup, email it to the Scoutmaster.
- 7. After the Scoutmaster and Troop Eagle Project Coach are satisfied with the initial Project Proposal:
 - The Troop Eagle Project Coach will email the PDF file to the District Project Approval Representatives.
- 8. One of the District Project Approval Representatives will then be assigned to review your project. He/she will contact you and possibly ask for further revisions.
- 9. Once the District Project Approval Representative is satisfied, and you have obtained his/her signature, you can start you project. Begin writing the **Eagle Scout Service Project Final Plan**.

The Eagle Scout Service Project Final Plan

- 1. The Final Plan must be completed before the first day of your project.
- 2. Email your Final Plan to the Troop Eagle Project Coach for review.
- 3. You may go through several revisions before the Troop Eagle Project Coach is satisfied with your Final Plan.

The Eagle Scout Service Project Report

- 1. Once your project is completed, finish by writing the Project Report.
- 2. Email your completed project writeup to the Troop Eagle Project Coach.
- 3. Once the Troop Eagle Project Coach is satisfied with your writeup, email it to the Scoutmaster.
- 4. After the Scoutmaster and Troop Eagle Project Coach are satisfied with the project writeup, obtain their signatures on the completed Project Report.

The entire **Eagle Scout Service Project Workbook** is needed when you are ready to schedule you Eagle Board of Review.
